

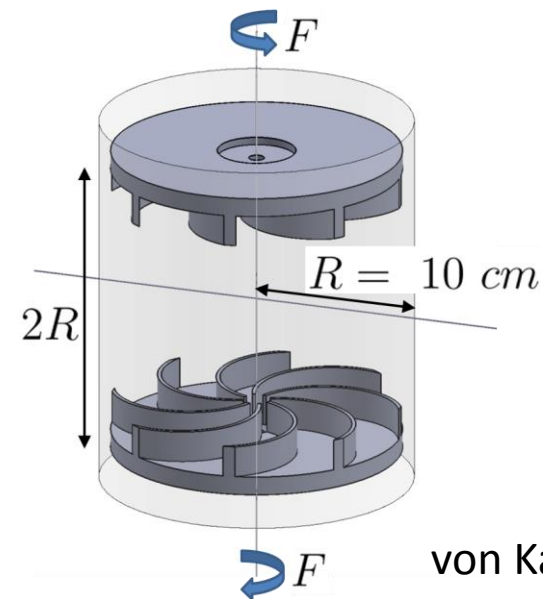
# Looking for prints of singularities in an experimental turbulent swirling flow



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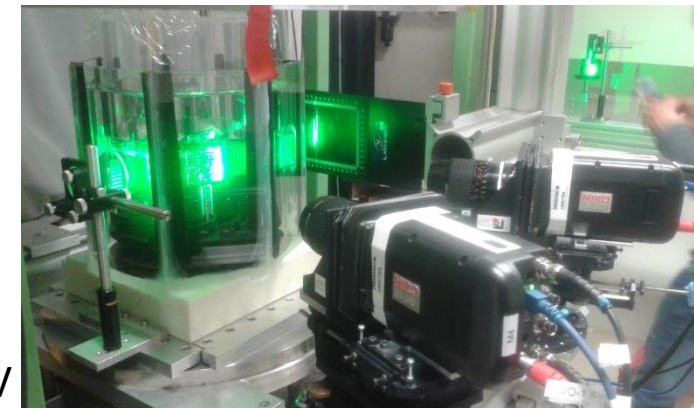
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von Kármán flow

$$\left\{ \begin{array}{l} \partial_t \mathbf{u} + \mathbf{u} \cdot \nabla \mathbf{u} = -\nabla p + \nu \Delta \mathbf{u} \\ \nabla \cdot \mathbf{u} = 0 \end{array} \right.$$

Tomographic PIV



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Weak Kármán-Howarth-Monin equation :

$$\partial_t \frac{\mathbf{u} \cdot \mathbf{u}^\ell}{2} + \nabla \cdot \mathbf{J}^\ell = \underbrace{-\frac{1}{4} \int \nabla \phi^\ell \cdot \delta \mathbf{u} (\delta \mathbf{u})^2}_{\text{Inter-scale transfer}} - \underbrace{\nu \int \Delta \phi^\ell \frac{\delta \mathbf{u}^2}{2}}_{\text{Viscous dissipation}}$$
